(56) Program 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Cash asked:

What is the English language requirement for attaining a subclass 485 visa? How does it compare to the English language requirements for accessing a student visa?

Answer.

The English language requirement for attaining a subclass 485 visa is competent English. This means:

- an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test score of at least 6 for each of the four test components of speaking, reading, writing and listening; or
- a score of at least 'B' in each of the four components of an Occupational English Language test; or
- that the applicant holds a specified passport.

The English language proficiency requirements for Student visas are determined by the relevant Assessment Level as per the table below.
