Senator Cash asked:

What are the anticipated costs and costs incurred to date of cases where failed asylum seekers are seeking injunctions (against the Commonwealth) to prevent removals.

Answer.

An application for injunctive relief to prevent removal is ordinarily only sought as part of a larger litigation matter, for example, as part of an application for judicial review of an adverse decision relating to a substantive visa application. The Department does not keep records of the costs of the component parts of litigation matters.
