Senator Cash asked:

Why do chefs and cooks remain outside the schedule 1 skilled occupations covered by the 457 visa? What is the policy rationale for this decision?

Answer.

The occupations of cook and chef are both eligible occupations under the subclass 457 visa program. Both occupations are listed in schedule 1 of legislative instrument IMMI 10/085, "Specification of occupations for nominations in relation to Subclass 457 (Business (Long Stay)) and Subclass 442 (Occupational Trainee) visas".

In 2011-12 to 31 January 2012 there have been 1,195 subclass 457 visas granted to cooks and chefs, with 63 per cent of these grants to cooks.
