(AE12/0510) Program 4.2: Onshore Detention Network

Senator Hanson-Young asked:

Criminal Justice Stay Certificates: How many of those held in immigration detention pursuant to criminal justice stay certificates claimed (or claim) to be children?

Answer:

As at 11 April 2012 there was one client in immigration detention who claims to be a minor and who is the subject of a criminal justice stay certificate. The client, who had previously been remanded in custody, was bailed to immigration detention in February 2012 on the basis of his claims to be a minor and is located at the Darwin Airport Lodge, Alternative Place of Detention.
