- In January 2013 the supply contract for the Tribunal's Melbourne Registry expired and a new 3 year contract with Origin Energy (incumbent supplier) was entered aftermarket testing. The supply arrangements for all other registries remain unchanged.

#### **Australian Customs and Border Protection Service**

1) Following a Prequalified Tender process, 11 small sites in Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia were contracted to Origin Energy for a 3 year period from 1 March 2013 and 2 small sites were contracted to Aurora energy for supply in Tasmania from 1 March 2013 to 30 June 2015. All other sites are supplied under existing arrangements. Under the Whole of Government contract, a change was made from 1 December 2012 to the tariff rate for one ACT site with potential annual savings estimated to be \$8,267.
