Senator Humphries asked the following question at the hearing on 12 February 2013:

Senator HUMPHRIES: Can you tell us from which countries these [performance or image enhancing] drugs are principally being imported?

Mr Pezzullo: If there is anything I can add, I will need to come back to the committee. I have got the aggregate levels of seizures that we have detected both in terms of steroids and hormones. Some of that is described in the ACC report. Whether I can give you a country breakdown, I will have to have a look at that and see if there is anything I can usefully provide to the committee.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

During 2012 Customs and Border Protection made 10,480 detections of Performance and Image Enhancing Drugs (PIEDs). The top four embarkation points for these detections were the USA, China, Thailand and Hong Kong which accounted for 81% of total detections. The top 10 embarkation points as shown in the table below, accounted for 91% of total detections for 2012.
