## **Question No. 21**

## Senator Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 12 February 2013:

**Senator BRANDIS**: Has Customs seized any illegal shipments of cigars in the past six months and, if so, how many?

**Mr Pezzullo**: I am just not sure that we get whole shipments of cigars. We will check, but the answer—being the recollection of the relevant competent officers—is that we cannot recall shipments of cigars.

**Senator BRANDIS**: Can I rephrase the question and ask for quantities?

Mr Pezzullo: Sure.

Senator BRANDIS: You will take that on notice?

Mr Pezzullo: Yes.

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Between 1 July 2012 and 31 January 2013 Customs and Border Protection made six detections of cigars totalling 2080 cigars and 1.1 kg of cigar products.
