What fee structures has the agency agreed with airlines for administration of the Government's Passenger Movement Charge (PMC)?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

In accordance with individual formal Arrangements signed between the Australian Customs and Border Protection Service (Customs and Border Protection) and airlines, the Commonwealth has agreed to reimburse airlines for costs incurred directly and solely as a result of the collection and remittance of PMC.
