**(AE13/0078) PROGRAM – 4.3: Offshore Asylum Seeker Management**

Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 85) asked:

At the end of the pre-transfer assessment form, the last section, section eight, 'Finding by senior case manager,' they have to indicate that they either (a) agree with the assessment that has been made or (b) do not agree with the assessment that has been made. How many of the assessments that have been made has the senior case manager not agreed with?
