Please detail the sporting facilities that are available at Immigration Detention Centres. Please provide a list of facilities by IDC. What has been the specific maintenance costs for these facilities for the financial years 2010-11, 2011-12, and 2012 to date?

Answer:

A list of the sporting facilities at each Immigration Detention Centre follows:

Christmas Island

Cricket and soccer field, indoor volleyball and basketball court, tennis court.

Lilac and Aqua

Two pool tables in Lilac and two pool tables in Aqua.

Northern Immigration Detention Centre

Gym, two football fields, five beach-volleyball courts, walking track with three exercise stations, two basketball courts, badminton court, basketball court, 'five-a-side' soccer field.

Maribyrnong Immigration Detention Centre

Male gym, female gym, basketball court, multipurpose area.

Villawood Immigration Detention Centre

Two soccer fields, half-basketball court, three-on-three-basketball/ volleyball court, three gyms.

Perth Immigration Detention Centre

Basketball court, gym equipment in two locations.

Wickham Point Immigration Detention Centre

Soccer pitch, three netball courts, three external gyms, three internal gyms, multipurpose area.

Yongah Hill IDC

Two soccer pitches, open-sided gymnasium containing two basketball courts and a raised area for cardio-vascular and resistance training, 500m walking/running track, twelve volleyball courts.

Pontville APOD (formerly IDC)

Gym, three outdoor volleyball courts, oval.

Scherger IDC

Gym, cardio room, volleyball court, multi-use court, swimming pool.

Curtin IDC

Two gyms, two cardio rooms, oval, two cricket nets, multipurpose area, three volleyball courts, two basketball courts.

The maintenance costs of these sporting facilities are not recorded or accounted for separately from other maintenance costs in Immigration Detention Centres, and they cannot readily be isolated.
