(AE13/0350) PROGRAM – 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Cash (Written) asked:

Has the department assessed any applications from IMA's for complementary protection? How many have satisfied that criteria and been given a permanent protection visa and over what period of time? Have any assessments against complementary protection criteria been refused?

Answer:

All applications for protection assessed after 24 March 2012 have had complementary protection (CP) criteria considered where the applicant did not engage Australia's *non-refoulement* obligations under the Refugees Convention.

Since the introduction of CP there have been 45 protection visa grants given on complementary protection grounds.
