Is the Minister required to conduct all interventions personally? If so, can you confirm all Ministerial interventions are being conducted by the Assistant Minister? What was the reason for this? Under what instrument is it allowed?

Answer:

The Minister's public interest intervention powers can be exercised by the Minister, Assistant Ministers or Parliamentary Secretaries within the portfolio.

Both the Minister and the Assistant Minister are exercising the ministerial intervention powers.
