What are the details of that lease agreement?

What will the site be used for?

Answer:

The Department of Immigration and Border Protection leased Leonora Alternative Place of Detention (APOD) from Outback Parks and Lodges Pty Ltd (OPL). The lease with OPL was terminated on 28 February 2014. The future use of this facility is a matter for the owner to consider.
