Senator Evans asked the following question at the hearing on 24 May 2006:

How much funding has gone into the Indigenous stream of Crime Prevention?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The National Community Crime Prevention Programme (NCCPP) has three funding streams:

- Partnership stream
- Indigenous Community Safety stream
- Community Safety stream

The first two funding rounds of the NCCPP committed \$2,029,306 under the Indigenous Community Safety stream for 16 projects. In addition, six projects with an Indigenous focus, amounting to \$1,641,294, have been funded under the Partnership and Community Safety streams of the NCCPP.
