**Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 24 May 2007**

Does the OFLC make submissions to public inquiries?

**The answer to the honourable senator's questions is as follows:**

Yes.

Under new administrative arrangements that will take effect on 1 July 2007, the Office of Film and Literature Classification will cease to exist as a separate agency. It will be integrated into the Attorney-General's Department and the Department will provide the secretariat for both independent Boards – the Classification Board and the Classification Review Board. If either Board wished to make a submission to a public inquiry, it could draw on the secretariat's resources to assist it in doing so.
