Senator Crossin (L&CA 51) asked:

Under the temporary residents economic visa, what percentage abide by their visa conditions? Has it increased or decreased since the last financial year? What percentage of visa holders have undergone a compliance check, and has that decreased?

Answer:

The percentage of Subclass 457 (Business (Long Stay)) visa holders who abide by all their visa conditions is not readily available.

Records show that in 2006-07, 1.08 per cent of Subclass 457 visa holders came to the attention of compliance for visa overstay. For the 2007-08 program year to 30 November 2007, 1.34 per cent of Subclass 457 visa holders came to the attention of compliance for visa overstay.
