Senator Siewert asked the following question at the hearing on 27 May 2008:

Does the Budget allow for costs associated with pursuing international litigation against Japan for its whaling practices? If so, how much?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Costs associated with pursuing international litigation against Japan were not considered in the 2008/09 Budget, as no decision has yet been made to pursue such litigation. The Government is carefully considering international legal action and will make a decision at an appropriate time. Should a decision be taken to commence a case, the Government would consider budget implications.
