The circular is also provided to the Attorney-General's office and the Department. This circular is provided as an attachment to the response to Question No 6.

On 20 April 2009, the Attorney-General's Department contacted the Commission to seek information about the Commission's attendance at the Conference. On 22 April 2009, the Commission advised that the Race Discrimination Commissioner, the Director of the Race Discrimination Unit and a Senior Policy Officer in the Race Discrimination Unit were in attendance.
