The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

In his roles as both the national Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Social Justice Commissioner, and the national Race Discrimination Commissioner, Tom Calma maintains a busy schedule. Mr Calma has been involved in the following faith based events on behalf of the Commission:

- 8 July 2008- Australian Partnership of Religious Organisations meeting, Sydney; attended by representative Conrad Gershevitch (Director, Education and Partnerships Section).
- 24 August 2008- attended multi-faith music event, Papatoetoe NZ, as part of the New Zealand human rights commission diversity action program.
- 28 August 2008- Religious Diversity in the Asia Pacific meeting, Auckland, New Zealand; attended by representative Conrad Gershevitch (Director, Education and Partnerships Section).
- 7 December 2008- Bahai community function, speech given by representative Conrad Gershevitch (Director, Education and Partnerships Section).
- 8 February 2009- gave speech at Parliament of World Religions event at Melbourne Town Hall.
- 16 June 2009- Australian Partnership of Religious Organisations forum, Adelaide, attended by representative Conrad Gershevitch (Director, Education and Partnerships Section).
