Provide the numbers of overstayers located and removed over the last six years and provide the percentage of the breakdown.

Answer.

The table below compares the size of the pool of overstayers in the Australian community with the size of the groups of overstayers located and removed in the relevant year. This table does not report locations and removals where the person has not overstayed their visa. For example, the table does not include locations of people in breach of other visa conditions and removal of people where the visa was cancelled.
