I am asking for a snapshot. Migrants have gone into Victoria, but have they gone into regional Victoria or into metropolitan areas?

Answer.

The following statistics are provided in response to Senator Fierravanti-Wells' question.

These statistics are drawn from a number of data sources across Commonwealth agencies, including Medicare. They include data collected in non-mandatory forms, and include a significant number where residence is unknown. Recent years figures include high numbers where residence is unknown, and over time this figure reduces as new data becomes available.
