Question No. 46

Senator Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2010:

How has the \$23.5 million in the budget paper been derived?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

This measure identified savings in the context of efficiencies available through the implementation of the recommendations of the Federal Audit of Police Capabilities (the Beale Review). The Beale Review identified efficiencies in the long term through the consolidation of the AFP budget and the implementation of the 'All-In' model for aviation security. The measure included the following components:

- Implementation of the Aviation 'All-In' Model and the integration of the Counter Terrorism First Response (CTFR) capability into the aviation security model;
- Greater integration of aviation and border operational activities at airport locations; and
- Internal Administrative Efficiencies that related to AFP corporate activities.
