Provide details of the consultations to date that the Australian government has had with the UNHCR and IOM.

Answer.

Australian officials have been consulting with UNHCR and IOM officials since at least November 2010 in relation to the establishment of a regional cooperation framework and possible means by which to implement arrangements. Detailed discussions relating specifically to the Malaysia Arrangement commenced in April 2011.
