Senator Pratt (L&CA 61) asked:

What was the repair bill as a result of a number of riots under the previous government, as in before 2007? What was that damage bill and how does it compare to the repair bill for recent damages?

Answer.

According to departmental records for the period 2000-2007, the damage bill was approximately \$20 million.

The estimated repair bill, as at 24 May 2011, for recent damages is \$8.5 million.

All damages are covered by either the detention services provider's insurance or by the department's Comcover insurance.
