Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 72) asked:

In relation to the people who have arrived since the announcement on 7 May 2011:

(a) how many children are being held?

(b) in which facility on Christmas Island is this group being held?

Answer.

(a) As at 29 August 2011, there were 228 minors who were intercepted aboard suspected irregular entry vessels since the Prime Minister's joint statement with the Prime Minister of Malaysia on 7 May 2011.

(b) These minors are being accommodated in a range of alternative places of detention on Christmas Island and the mainland.
