Senator Cash asked:

How many asylum seekers detained on Christmas Island have been transported to the mainland for health reasons? What are those reasons? What conditions have been treated?

Answer:

From 1 July 2010 to 4 February 2011, a total of 82 clients were transported from Christmas Island to the mainland, for the following health reasons:
