If the workload is seasonal, why aren't additional resources brought on board each season to cope with the demand?

Answer:

The Student visa and Visitor caseloads have significant seasonal peaks relating to academic semester intakes and holiday patterns respectively. The Department puts various strategies in place to manage these peaks, which include engaging additional staff on a short-term basis as well as shifting resources between business lines.
