IMMIGRATION AND CITIZENSHIP PORTFOLIO

(BE13/0291) PROGRAM – 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Cash (Written) asked:

How many multi-entry tourist visas have been granted in 2011-12 and 2012-13 to date, by nationality of applicant and post?

Answer:

Of all the tourist visas granted to persons outside Australia, 88.6 per cent (2 710 495) provided multiple entry in 2011-12 and 88.7 per cent (2 337 214) in 2012-13 as at 30 April 2013. These figures include the following visa subclasses: Tourist (Subclass 676), and tourist streams for the Visitor (Subclass 600), Electronic Travel Authority (Subclasses 601 and 976), and eVisitor (Subclass 651).

A detailed breakdown of multiple entry tourist visas by applicant nationality and visa issuing office would be thousands of lines. The following tables indicate the top ten applicant nationality and visa issuing offices for multiple entry tourist visas.
