Expenses relate primarily to meals and drinks provided to foreign dignitaries or key stakeholders in order to build stakeholder relationships.

- (b) For the 2012–13 financial year to date, DIAC expended \$5,160.92 for official hospitality on behalf of the Hon Chris Bowen, MP, former Minister for Immigration and Citizenship (Minister Bowen). There have been four functions as listed below.
 - \$1,640.00 was to support the meeting of the Select Council on Immigration and Settlement, the Ministerial Council established under the Council of Australian Governments (COAG), for which Minister Bowen was chair. The meeting was held on 7 August 2012 at the National Convention Centre, Canberra
 - \$2,766.81 was for dinner hosted by Minister Bowen for senior representatives of the Government of Papua New Guinea to undertake high-level discussions. The dinner was held on 4 October 2012 at the Airways Hotel, Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea
 - \$180.00 was for dinner hosted by Minister Bowen for senior representatives of the Government of Lebanon. The dinner provided the opportunity to build and expand relationships. The dinner was held on 22 October 2012 at the Head of Missions residence in Beirut, Lebanon
 - \$574.11 was for dinner hosted by Minister Bowen for senior representatives of the Government of Lebanon and key stakeholders. The dinner was held to undertake high level discussions and build relationships. The dinner was held on 23 October 2012 at Zaituna Bay Restaurant, Beirut, Lebanon.

For the 2012–13 financial year to date, DIAC has expended \$2,282.48 for official hospitality on behalf of the Hon Brendan O'Connor, Minister for Immigration and Citizenship. Minister O'Connor was sworn in as Minister for Immigration and Citizenship on 4 February 2013. There have been three functions as listed below.

- \$1,927.53 was for a cocktail reception hosted by Minister O'Connor for senior Papua New Guinean government officials. The reception provided the opportunity to build and expand relationships. The reception was held on 25 February 2013 at the Airways Hotel, Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea.
- \$280.55 was for a lunch hosted by Minister O'Connor for senior representatives of the government of Sri Lanka. The lunch provided the opportunity to build and expand relationships. The lunch was held on 2 May 2013 at the Dutch Hospital, Colombo, Sri Lanka.

 \$74.40 was for a dinner hosted by Minister O'Connor for senior representatives of the government of Sri Lanka. The dinner provided the opportunity to build and expand relationships. The dinner was held on Thursday 2 May 2013 at the Head of Mission's residence, Colombo, Sri Lanka.

For the 2012–13 financial year to date, DIAC expended \$4,160.82 for official hospitality on behalf of Senator the Hon Kate Lundy, Minister for Multicultural Affairs. There have been two functions as listed below.

- \$3,221.82 was for a lunch hosted by Senator Lundy for the People of Australia Ambassadors and the Chair and Deputy Chair of the Australian Multicultural Council. The purpose of this event was to officially congratulate the 2012 Ambassadors on the completion of the first term of the program. The lunch was held at the Australian Botanical Gardens, Canberra on 10 December 2012 at the Australian Botanical Gardens, Canberra.
- \$939.00 was for an afternoon tea hosted by Senator Lundy for a special budget briefing for ethnic media. The afternoon tea provided the opportunity to build and expand relationships. The afternoon tea was held on Wednesday 15 May 2013 at Parliament House, Canberra.

For the 2012–13 financial year to date, DIAC has not expended any funds for official hospitality on behalf of Senator the Hon Matt Thistlethwaite, Parliamentary Secretary for Multicultural Affairs.

- (e) DIAC expects that expenditure on official hospitality for 2012–13 will be consistent with 2011–12 expenditure and will be approximately \$150 000. Detailed information on planned official hospitality expenditure is not available.
- (f) DIAC is not currently planning any hospitality spend for any Minister or Parliamentary Secretary.
- (g) DIAC does not differentiate between hospitality and entertainment. Please refer to answer (e).
- (h) DIAC is not currently planning any entertainment spend for any Minister or Parliamentary Secretary.

(i) The current level of expenditure on hospitality and entertainment is considered appropriate for a department that has international engagement with many stakeholder groups. However, DIAC will continue to focus on cost effective outcomes.
