- b) the average length of processing time for under bond movement authorities each day
- c) how many were performed through COMPILE
- d) how many were performed through ICS
- e) how many were performed through CCF
- f) how many were performed manually
- g) how many staff were engaged in processing under bond movement authorities

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- c) COMPILE does contain functionality for processing under-bond movement authorities.
- d) The following table contains the processing numbers for ICS EDI messages and the time between the receiving of the under bond report into Customs to the time the associated response message (informing the client that the under bond movement authority had been granted) leaves Customs.
