a) Regarding the statement that the rates Australian Security Vetting Service pays are commercial in confidence, please justify the commercial in confidence?

(b) If possible, please possible the rates in a redacted form?

(c) If not, why not?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The ASVS operates in a competitive environment with other agencies and private companies offering personnel security vetting services. For this reason, the rates that the ASVS pays its contractors are commercial-in-confidence.
