Senator Evans asked:

Are program funds now only available through SRAs, or can communities still apply for funding without an SRA?

Answer:

Program funds are available to communities regardless of whether an SRA is in place. Communities can apply for funding from a range of programs (Indigenous specific and mainstream) through usual funding processes. For example, programs transferred to mainstream agencies from ATSIC/ATSIS use a common funding application process. A call for funding applications for 2006-07 was advertised in early December 2005.
