Senator Siewert asked:

- 1. Is the OIPC conducting or participating in a review of the Native Title Act (1993), either formally or informally?
- 2. If so, is it possible to outline the broad policy approach which the OIPC is taking in any such review?

Answer:

- 1. As the *Native Title Act* (1993) is, except for Part 11 (which is administered by the Office of Indigenous Policy Coordination), the responsibility of the Attorney-General's Department, the Office would not co-ordinate any review.
 - The OIPC is not involved in any review of the *Native Title Act (1993)*, other than in those reviews which were announced by the Attorney-General on 7 September 2005.
- 2. It would be inappropriate for the Office to publicly canvas internal policy deliberations of this kind.
