Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 31 October 2006:

With reference to page 119 of the Annual report and regarding the additional funds for expanded capacity in Telecommunications and Surveillance Law, please advise as to whether:

- (a) The additional funds were fully expended.
- (b) The funding was sufficient or in excess of actual need.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

(a) The funds received on 1 July 2006 have not yet been fully expended, as the funds were provided to cover the entire 2006/07 financial year.

The funds received on 1 July 2006 have been utilised to create the Telecommunications and Surveillance Law Branch within the Security and Critical Infrastructure Division of the Department.

The Branch comprises 3 sections which have a total of 18 positions. Recruitment for vacant positions within the Branch was finalised in October 2006.

(b) At this stage in the financial year the Branch is on budget, with the funds allocated sufficient to meet the objects of the Branch.
