There are also plans to secure a long-term lease on the Anzac Park East (APE) Building. A business case is currently being prepared and will be subject to the government approvals processes. If approved, APE will involve significant fit-out costs which the AFP plans to internally fund. Total expected capital expenditure outlays for APE are currently being determined.
