On 6 September 2006 in Question Time the Minister stated that she would investigate the allegation that a pregnant family member on a 457 visa was forced to return to China. The principal 457 visa holder was employed by ABC Tissues at its Queensland site.

- 1. Has the Department investigated this case? What was done to investigate this allegation?
- 2. What was the outcome of the investigation?
- 3. Can the Department confirm that a pregnant family member was required to return to China?
- 4. Can the Department confirm that if that person had remained in Australia the employer would have been liable for all medical expenses related to the birth of the child?
- 5. Is the Department aware of similar cases?

Answer:

- 1. Yes. The Department found that the pregnant family member was covered by health insurance.
