Subject: Return of Pakistani nationals.

Excellency,

Kindly refer to your letter dated 23 October, 2002 regarding return of Pakistani nationals to Pakistan.

2. A chart, giving present status of all the 9 cases, referred to in your letter under acknowledgement, is attached. The persons at serial numbers 1, 2, 3 and 7 can be issued with travel documents on receipt of the enclosed prescribed application forms, completed in all respects.

3. According to Pakistani Police authorities, the persons at serial numbers 4, 5 and 8 are (obviously) not residing at the given addresses in Pakistan and are not even known by the people of the area. As such, their national status needs to be verified. For this purpose, I would be happy to interview them, as suggested by you.

4. The response of the Pakistani authorities in the remaining cases (serial numbers 6 and 9) is still awaited. We will revert to you on hearing from them.
