With regard to 457 compliance staffing levels and costs in 2004-2005 and 2005-2006. Is it projected that compliance numbers staff will increase?

Answer:

Caseload staffing numbers fluctuate in response to programme use. On the 30/10/2006 the minister announced additional resources for Subclass 457 monitoring and compliance resulting in an additional 27 staff to be engaged in 2006-07 including 5 investigators.
