Senator Conroy (L&CA written) asked:

- 1. What percentage of employers of 457 visa holders have been audited with respect to their compliance with relevant minimum rates of pay in the year to date?
- 2. What percentage of employers of 457 visa holders have been audited with respect to their compliance with relevant minimum rates of pay in the 2004-05 financial year?
- 3. What percentage of employers of 457 visa holders have been audited with respect to their compliance with relevant minimum rates of pay in the 2003-04 financial year?
- 4. What percentage of employers of 457 visa holders have been audited with respect to their compliance with relevant minimum rates of pay in the 2002-03 financial year?

Answer:

In the years 2004-05, 2003-04, 2002-03 all employers were sent monitoring forms and followed up it if a response when not received. Not all responses are received in the year the monitoring form is sent. In the current year DIMA is moving to a more targeted, risk-based approach to monitoring such that monitoring forms are sent to high risk employers, noting that many 457 sponsors are government agencies. Random monitoring of lesser risk employers continue.
