(67) Program 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- 1. Has there been any drop off in applications from international students since hairdressing, welfare and cooking were dropped from the MODL?
- 2. How many colleges have been removed from CRICOS?
- 3. What is the trend of international Student visas being applied for and granted in 06-07, 07-08, 08-09?
- 4. Comparing applicants for the VET sector to the university sector what countries are they from?

Answer:

1. Hairdressing, welfare and cooking have not been removed from the Migration Occupations in Demand List. These occupations, however, are not included on the Critical Skills List introduced on 1 January 2009.

There was no drop off in the number of Student visa applications lodged in the 2008-09 program year.

In the 2007-08 program year 302,190 Student visa applications were lodged with the Department. In 2008-09 that number increased to 362,193 Student visa applications.

- 2. The Commonwealth Register of International Courses for Overseas Students (CRICOS) is administered by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR). DEEWR advises that in the 2008-09 financial year the CRICOS registration of 78 providers was recorded as cancelled.
- 3. The following table lists the number of Student visa applications and grants from 2006-07 to the 2008-09 program year.
