#### (136) Program 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Fifield asked:

(1) In 2010, what is the average processing time for Student visas student from Indian and Sri Lankan applicants? Please provide for 572 visa applications and 575 visa applications.

(2) What are the comparable average processing times for the years 2006-2009 inclusive?

*Answer:*

For Indian nationals, Vocational Education and Training (subclass 572) is AL4 and Non-award (subclass 575) is AL 3.

For Sri Lankan nationals, Vocational Education and Training (subclass 572) is AL4 and Non-award (subclass 575) is AL 3.

The published service standard for an AL3-4 application is 90 days for an offshore application and 30 days for an onshore application.
