Senator Cash asked:

1) In 2009-10 financial year and 2010 year to date, how many irregular maritime arrivals sought refugee status by nationality and country of origin?

2) How many of those lodged protection visa applications by nationality and country of origin?

Answer.

1 & 2) The information requested is contained in the table below. For arrivals since 1 July 2010, none were eligible by 27 October 2010 to lodge protection visa applications, because the Minister had not exercised the power to allow such applications following assessment of their claims for protection.

The following table provides a break down by nationality and financial year of the numbers of people making claims and the numbers of people who having been found to be refugees have made Protection visa applications and have been granted Protection visas.
