# (225) Program 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

### Senator Cash asked:

How many applicants were granted refugee status in the first instance by the department in each category by country of nationality and origin in 2009-10 and so far in 2010-11?

### Answer.

2480 people were found to be refugees and were granted Protection visas in the first instance by the Department in the 2009-10 financial year.

340 people were found to be refugees and were granted Protection visas in the 2010-11 financial year to 27 October 2010.

The following table provides a breakdown by nationality of the numbers of people who having been found to be refugees in the first instance by the Department and have been granted Protection visas.
