What is the Department/Agency's hospitality spend for the year 2010-11 and what hospitality spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events.
What is the Department/Agency's entertainment spend for the year 2010-11 and what entertainment spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events.

## Answer:

- The amount spent on Official Hospitality and Entertainment for the period 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011 was \$122 710 of which $\$ 47556$ was spent in the offshore environment.
- Expenses relate primarily to meals provided to foreign dignitaries in order to build stakeholder relationships.
