Expenditure executive coaching and leadership training services

During the 2010-2011 financial year and the current FYTD, the department spent \$128,372 on purchasing executive coaching and/or other leadership training services. The Global Learning and Change Branch (GLCB) has provided one senior leadership program crossing the years 2010-2011 and FYTD for 11 staff members. All EL2 staff members (totalling 380) were eligible to apply.

The GLCB offers other leadership training for APS4-EL1 staff delivered internally at no supplier cost.
