(SE11/0188) Program 2.1: Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance

Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 22) asked:

For people settled from Indonesia, provide the figures from the period 2009 to February 2011.

Answer:

Between 1 January 2009 and 28 February 2011, 638 people were granted humanitarian visas by the Australian Embassy, Jakarta.¹ Of these:

- 572 were subclass 200 (Refugee) visas
- 45 were subclass 202 (Special Humanitarian Program) visas
- 21 were subclass 204 (Woman at Risk) visas
