Senator Cash asked:

Serco contract: What is the value of damage caused to the immigration network during 2009-2010; 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 and what amount was claimed by the Government for this damage. What amount was paid to the Government as a result of this damage?

Answer.

As at 31 October 2011, the value of claimable damage caused to the immigration network during the 2009-2010; 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 was \$17,636,366. A breakdown of this is listed in the table below:
