Detention centres and facilities – people: What has been the total repair bill to damage sustained as a result of unrest and riots by detainees at all of the detention facilities and centres in the 2010-2011 financial year and the year to date? Please provide a breakdown by facility and type of damage.

Answer:

As at 31 October 2011, the estimated costs associated with unrest and riots by detainees for the 2010/2011 financial year were \$14,947,921. A breakdown of this is listed below.
