SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES HEARING: 17 OCTOBER 2011

Senator Cash asked:

Since last estimates, has there been any security breaches recorded at the Inverbrackie facility? If so, how many, and please provide details of each security breach.

Answer:

The table below indicates the security breaches that have occurred at Inverbrackie since May 2011.

Date	Reason
12 June 2011	Misplacement – vehicle keys
29 June 2011	Property office – client cash missing. Investigation undertaken as per contractual requirements.
9 July 2011	Vehicle keys – went missing, offsite excursion
12 August 2011	Local school notified Serco that a client had left their care. Serco located the client and returned him to the facility.
1 September 2011	During routine search of worksite a nail gun was found in unoccupied building
3 September	Due to the low risk nature of the facility, a client was located outside the perimeter. At no point did Serco lose sight of the client and Officers returned the client to the facility. The client was unaware they had breached security and had no intention to escape.
