Senator Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 16 October 2012:

Given the volume of work originating in the Gold Coast region, will the Court consider the establishment of a permanent registry in that area?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

The Federal Magistrates Court currently conducts 8 one-day circuits to the Gold Coast each year.

The following table shows the number of initiating applications filed at the Gold Coast and based on these filings, the FMC has not seen the need for a permanent registry in that area.
